

# "Strive to enter through the narrow door."

In the Old Testament the notion of the "way" to salvation is constitutive and predicated on being related to Abraham. In Genesis 17:7, God makes a powerful promise to Abraham: "I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your descendants after you." The Jews held on to this promise of salvation by heritage. In John 8:39 The Jews even proudly said to Jesus; "Abraham is our father..." Meaning salvation is assured, come what may.

In our text, Luke 13:22-30, Jesus shocks the audience when he says: "when you see Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but you yourselves thrown out." Jesus then invites them to: "Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to..." The implication of Jesus' call to enter through the narrow gate involves leaving other ways. Jesus is the way. He goes to Jerusalem to establish this gate/way by his death and resurrection.


#### 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time
