

ASK FATHER JAMES:

GIVING UP ONE'S LIFE AND POSSESSIONS AS CONDITION FOR BECOMING A TRUE DISCIPLE

This verse in today's Gospel text (Luke 14:25-33) 'If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife, and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple," has been read as one of the most difficult conditions for discipleship. This is a very harsh text had led some who desire sincerely to be faithful to Jesus Christ, to back out. But what does He mean? How can we hate our families? Our children? Ourselves? How can we renounce all our possessions, down to the very smallest, as Jesus asks? How should we understand this text?

The word translated in the English as "hate" actually is transliterated from the verb to "give up" (NRSV) and it means to say "farewell" (apotasso). Jesus is telling us how to be church. What can you give up for Christ? What can you say "farewell" to for Christ's sake? Sports! Game day! Lake! Holiday trip! Movie or concert show! Etc. What can one say farewell to, so that we go to meet Jesus at Mass? If I'm honest, I know that it is sometimes very hard to give up any of the above listed and some more events of on our daily/weekly plan. The decision to go to Mass is a perfect time/day for reflection on this call to give up some of our relationships and attachments. What freedom of the will can we "give up" for Christ. Jesus never asks us to do what is impossible. Discipleship isn't about "giving up" everything and everyone to never see them again. When Jesus uses the phrase "not able to be my disciple," the phrase refers to something the person is able to do but chooses not to do.


