

## Finding the "lost" people of our church (Luke 15)

Luke 15 contains three parables: the parables of the lost sheep, lost coin, and the lost prodigal son. Jesus tells these parables to remind all church members to do something about lost church members. Search for them! The three parables that Jesus told in Luke 15, reveal God as a Searching Father, looking for the lost, actively seeking them, and rejoicing when they are found. We too can see ourselves in the Prodigal Son. We were once lost and have been found and that is why we have been invited to the eternal banquet for celebration. God wants us to join Him in the search by going out and seek and search for others who are still lost. There are many of them out there! Those who seldom attend church. What about the husband of the faithful who stay at home to watch football? What about those in our churches who seem to drop out of regular attendance? What about the younger generation? What about those who are still hurting for one reason or another. We all must go searching for them until we find them. In the v. 28 of today's parable, we are asked to do what that father did: "... So his father went out and pleaded with him." (Luke 15:28).


