# What does it mean to be a disciple with your money?

Jesus in Luke 16:13 says: "No servant can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money." (Luke 16:13). How a person spends money, tells you what their values are. Jesus is saying that a person isn't a committed Christian until his money is also committed to God. How would God have us spend our money"? As individuals, as a family and as church! This is the meditation for this week.

In this week's Gospel text, "Jesus told us, his disciples: 'There was a rich man whose manager was accused of wasting and squandering his possessions.... So, he called him in and asked him, 'What is this I hear about you? Give an account of your management because you cannot be manager any longer.'" (Luke 16:1-2)." The word "squander" or "wasting" is the same word used in earlier verses to describe the "prodigal son." (See Luke 15:13). Money decisions have spiritual implications or lest, those decisions become self-serving decisions. The main idea of the parable is to use one's resources for the purpose of making an impact in the kingdom of God. When that steward was confronted about his wastefulness, he took quick action. In the parable, the steward was commended for his shrewdness in making his master recover lost monies. Jesus invites Christians too, to use their quick wits for the sake of the kingdom.
