ASK FATHER JAMES:

Corpus Christi: Jesus Calls us to be a Eucharistic People

In today's gospel reading, (Luke 9:16a) Jesus: "Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke them...." This foreshadows what Jesus did at the Last Supper. "Corpus Christi: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ" is all about what we Catholic Church believe about this Sacrament. At the Last Supper, when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me. "And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood." Our usage of the word "Eucharist" describes what Jesus did: He lifts his eyes to heaven and "gave thanks." The word comes from the Greek word is for thanksgiving is *eucharisteo*. At every Mass, we are called to be a eucharistic church; a church that continually gives thanks. Just as Jesus looks up to heaven and gives thanks, at Mass, the gaze of the Church is constantly turned to her Lord, present in the Sacrament of the Altar, in which she discovers the full manifestation of his boundless love.


Bingos will again be increasing. HELP IS NEEDED..... 3 & 3.5 hour shifts.


