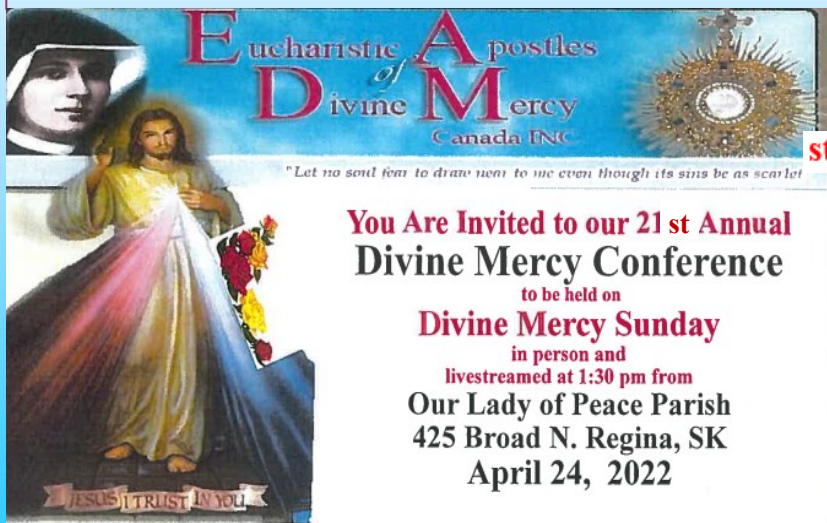

ASK FATHER JAMES:

Easter: The Goal of Our Lenten Journey

The journey we undertook at the beginning of Lent brings us to the encounter with the risen Christ. Our celebration of Holy Thursday in the liturgy helps us come to an appreciable understanding of the place of the table (Altar) liturgical meal fellowship with Jesus himself who through the crucial declaration said: "This is my Body given for you." Therefore, we are asked to participate actively in this celebration. In the Good Friday celebration, the cross stands clearly and starkly as the central symbol. The veneration of the cross, the tree of life, is at the center of the Christian life because he died on the cross to save us, and hence we see the Paschal Mystery in all its fullness. "He humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death even death on a cross" (Philippians 2:8). In celebrating the Easter vigil, we celebrate our configuration to Christ through our baptism; being reminded of our baptismal call and as we responded and renewed our baptismal promises in the Creed, we experience the transforming power of the Word of God as we listen to the Vigil readings recounting God's great deeds in the lives of human beings. On Easter Sunday, the feast of encounter with the risen Lord, we lovingly encounter him. Our faith becomes enriched like the faith of the apostles and Mary Magdalen when they encountered the risen Jesus. Our faith is deepened, just as it was for Thomas and we walk in a new way with burning hearts, as did the disciples on the Road to Emmaus (John 29-21; Luke 24). As we celebrate Easter, "Let us continue to sing Alleluia here below while we are still on the journey so that we may sing it one day above in heaven when we have reached journeys end."

Holy Spirit Retreat

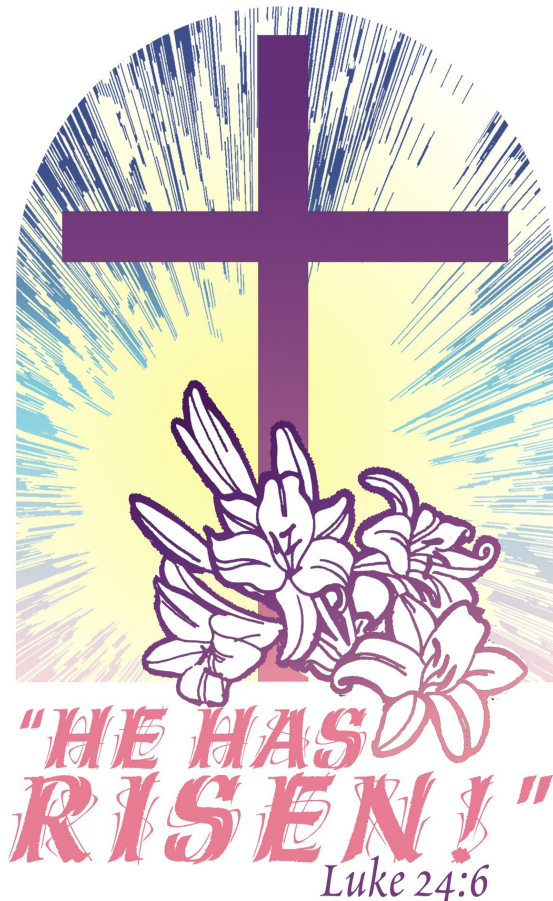
Join us April 22-24 for a Holy Spirit Retreat weekend!

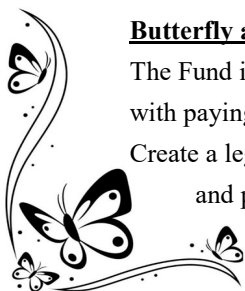

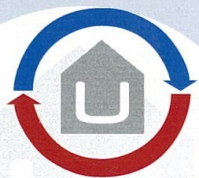
