

ASK FATHER JAMES:

Jesus: The Shepherd with Compassion (Matthew 9:36)

When Jesus saw the crowds, he describes them as "sheep without a shepherd" (Matthew 9:35-36). When Jesus said, they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd, Jesus here describes what man is apart from God; that we are like sheep having no shepherd. This means that we are in a lot of trouble until we come under the care of our Shepherd. The helplessness of the sheep requires a good shepherd who leads the flock to places of grazing and watering and protects the sheep from animal and human marauders. Like the Sheep who are totally dependent on shepherds for protection, grazing, watering, shelter, and tending to injuries, we too are dependent on our shepherd.

Shepherdess flock are "harassed and downtrodden" which connotes that the sheep is exposed leaving them vulnerable to attack by wild beasts ready to be devoured by them. The wild beasts would "tear those sheep into pieces" and "eat them." This is why Jesus came into the world. We too are "exposed." The beast is around the corner! Jesus asks us to pray for God to send laborers into his harvest. Without Jesus' intervention, we would have been devoured, swallowed, and snatched.

A Word About Trauma

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

Coping cop·ing - is a dynamic process that involves both cognitive and behavioural changes to manage stress. There are two major categories of coping: problem-focused and emotion-focused coping. Old English cope dress in cope and moving to mid 16^{th} century. Coping refers to conscious strategies used to reduce unpleasant emotions. Coping strategies can be cognitions or behaviours and can be individual or social.

The <u>fact</u> of <u>dealing successfully</u> with <u>problems</u> or <u>difficult situations</u>: a coping <u>mechanism/strategy</u>, coping <u>skills/abilities</u>.
