

Stewardship:

"Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed...He told them, 'Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come.'" - Mark 1:35, 38 In today's Gospel reading we see a perfect example of stewardship. Jesus gives His time to do all that God wishes - healing the sick and preaching. But before He begins, Jesus makes time to be alone with God in prayer. It is through prayer, spending time with God, that we find the strength to do what He wishes us to do. Be sure to find time every day to be with God.

Ask Fr. James

What do we Christians believe about Angels?

All the major religions of the world believe in Angels. Jews, Christians and Muslims, Buddhism, Hinduism, African traditional religion and Zoroastrianism all described angels as winged creatures. In the Christian Bible, Angels appear in more than half the books of the Bible: it was an angel who told Abraham to spare his son from sacrifice (Genesis 22:12), who saved Daniel from the lion's den (Daniel 6:22), they announced the birth of Jesus (Luke 2) and Jesus mentions angels in many instances and they rolled the stone away from Christ's tomb (Matthew 28:2).

The word angel in the Bible in its strictest translation from the Greek "angelos" simply means 'messengers' or 'ministers' who executes the will of the one whom they serve. Angels were first mentioned in the Book of Genesis as the guardians at the eastern gate of the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:24) According to the Bible there are nine hierarchies or orders/choirs of angels each with its own task; grouped in order of strength and importance:

1. The highest angels are the **seraphim** and **cherubim** who are continually in God's presence in worship and praise. (When we celebrate Mass, we join our voices with these angels and the heavenly hosts in singing Holy! Holy! Holy! in praise of God).
2. The **thrones** bring justice
3. The **dominions** regulate life in heaven
4. The **virtues** work miracles
5. The **powers** protect mankind from evil
6. The **principalities** are concerned with the welfare of nations
7. The **archangels and angels** serve as guides and messengers to individual human beings (guardian angels).

Angels are holy and are called hosts or "armies of heaven" who are sent to help us in spiritual warfare. They are not gods and neither are they ghosts or spirits of the dead. Worship of angels is absolutely forbidden because they are creatures of God who minister to us at the bidding of God. Angels were not created in the image of God as humans are but they can assume bodies as needed to carry out a task. They are non corporeal spiritual beings and have no gender but are superior to humans in power and intelligence.

The thrones, dominions, principalities and powers are the angels who carried the throne of God and bore sceptre and sword and protected the Prince of Heaven. When Jesus was asked to come into the world to save humanity, some of them rebelled in heaven. They rebelled because they didn't want humanity to be redeemed or saved and they thought their role would be diminished. They thought that if God became man in the son of God by taking human flesh, they would be serving a human person over whom they thought themselves superior. The Last Book of the Bible, the Book of Revelations describes how this war in heaven happened. Archangel Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and Lucifer was thrown out of heaven. The dragon was cast out, that old serpent called the devil and Satan was cast out unto the earth and his angels were cast out with him (Revelations 12: 7-12).

The angels who rebelled became the followers of Satan and fell to earth as problem causers. God did not stop their rebellion because Angels were created and given free will, just as humans were. Aside from these fallen angels, the rest angels continue to be loyal to God. Every where Jesus is, the angels are there with him. We join with the angels in worship of God at every Mass.


