ASK FATHER JAMES:

"Come to me, all you who are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest."

The above quote is from Matthew 11:28. It is one of the most comforting passages in scripture. With it, Jesus invites us to try him in our quest to attain "work-life balance." This is why we come to church, and this is why we receive Jesus in the Word and Sacraments, especially, the Holy Eucharist. This Jesus' invite is an invitation to experience the sabbath rest as God intended it since Genesis 2:2-3 when God established rest after work.

Thus, in this Sunday's gospel text, Jesus asks: Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out in any situation? Jesus says, come to me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest. Walk with me and work with me—watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly move on even with the load.

Jesus' approach to helping us achieve work-life balance is "take my yoke...." (v.29). A yoke was a wooden instrument that yoked two oxen together and made them a team. By this approach, Jesus is saying: "Become my yokemate and learn how to pull the load by working beside me and watching how I do it and we shall pull through together." Jesus left us an example in how he carried his own cross to his destination.


Refugee Field Worker
