ASK FATHER JAMES:

Jesus says, “Remember Elijah?” “Remember Elisha?” (Luke 4:21-30)

The biblical prophet Elijah is a well-known figure in Jewish tradition and is commonly believed to be the Messiah who will return at the end of days. He is the guest of honor at every Jewish ritual ceremony and at the annual Passover eve meal (Seder). In fact, a seat is reserved for Elijah at every Sabbath Day meal in the hope of the great expectation of the coming Messiah. The prophet Elisha too was everyone's favorite wonderworker.

Now, the people of Nazareth had been hearing reports of all the great things Jesus was doing in Capernaum and in all other cities. This hero was returning home and the people trooped to the Nazareth Synagogue to see him and to hear and expected to see some miracles. However, Jesus shows up in the Nazareth Synagogue and reminded them what scripture tells about these two important personages, Elijah, and Elisha: That during the time of great famine, Elijah was not sent to anyone from Nazareth or Jerusalem or even Capernaum, but instead a widow in Zarephath—a small town in Lebanon (1 Kings 17:8-14). And Jesus doesn't stop. “Remember Elisha?” he continues. Elisha's everyone's favorite wonderworker did not heal any leper in Israel but heals Naaman the Syrian (2 Kings 5:1-17). Jews have always understood Messianic prophecies as meaning that the Messiah comes for the Jews only. Their expectation was that [Jesus] “was a Jew and for the Jews.” Jesus came to be with us, whoever we are.

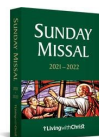

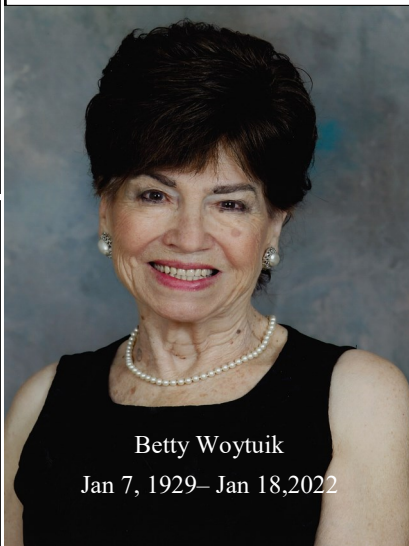
