**GREAT NEWS.....** Over almost ten years of Our Lady of Peace existence it became increasingly difficult to keep the Rectory properly repaired/maintained due to financial restraints. As a result, when Father Steve was about to move in last summer, it became apparent that it needed repairs of approx. \$20,000 – money which we did not have. Early January a communique regarding our parish's financial situation was handed out. In it we stated "the Rectory needed extensive repairs. Because of lack of funds to repair, we asked the Archdiocese for permission to sell".

However, \$12,000.00 of repairs and clean up was required to sell the rectory. The rectory was listed at \$259,900.00 on February 26<sup>th</sup>. On February 27<sup>th</sup> a second offer \$5,100.00 above the asking price was received and accepted. In the home inspection the sewer line was flagged. The cost of repair is \$5,000.00 This amount will be put in trust until repairs are completed. A net return of approx. \$235,000 @ interest of 4% = \$800/month will be invested in the Archiepiscopal Corporation.

We have rented, effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, accommodations conveniently located downtown for Fr. Steve. This will be a 5-year lease for a 2-bed condo at \$1,800/month including all utilities. The \$800.00 monthly interest will offset the condo rent leaving the net rent of \$1,000/month which is equal to what the monthly expenses of the rectory were. This influx of capital will be of great assistance in our quest to grow our Parish.

The Finance Committee sincerely thanks all those who were involved in this transaction and all who helped in preparing the rectory for sale.
