

Pastor's Message

St. Luke's gospel is the gospel of the oppressed and of the outcasts. It is the Gospel of Mercy.

In today's gospel we hear: "When the Lord saw her (*the woman, her only son had died*), he has compassion for her and said to her, "Do not weep." (Lk 7.13) then he raised him up from the dead and gave him to his mother. (Lk 7.14-15) Jesus quickly showed his compassion even though nobody asked him first.

We are in the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Pope Francis asks us to reflect on the words in St Luke's gospel: "Be merciful just as your Father is merciful." (Lk 6.35) We should look at Jesus as the wonderful example of mercy and reflect on it for our lives, for one another, and specially for those in need.

On this Sunday we also reflect on the power of our Lord. The power of his touching. St Luke very often uses the title 'the Lord' to talk about Jesus, who really cares for us. In today's Gospel St. Luke also use this title. He reported: "when the Lord saw her." (7.13) The Lord Jesus also cares for each one of us and our faith community. He willingly heals our wounds and saves us from the dead especially the spiritual dead, the dead of division. However, we must recognize our need of Jesus touching and be open to it. Jesus touches us in many ways, especially by his Eucharistic touching which is the most close as his touch becomes our nourishment to permeate into our lives.

We just celebrated the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on last Sunday. This celebration must continue to remind us about the most deepest touching of Jesus through the Eucharist that we need for healing as individuals and as a community so we may enjoy our full life in Christ.


