

Our Lady of Peace Parish

August 2020

Daily Mass is recorded Tuesday to Friday and available on our website by approximately 3:00 PM. Weekend Mass is available online Sunday mornings.

Currently, 70 people are allowed at each Mass. We kindly ask you adhere to the rules on entering the Church and maintain physical distance. Please keep yourself and others safe by following the Directives set out by the Archdiocese and the Government of Saskatchewan. Below, are the guidelines for attending Mass at Our Lady of Peace Parish.

- 1.) Saturday Mass 5:00 PM, Sunday Mass 9:00 AM & 11:00 AM (NOT 10:30 AM, time is needed to sanitized between Masses).
- 2.) **You MUST** conduct a self assessment of COVID-19 symptoms at home prior to attending Mass. **DO NOT ATTEND MASS** if you are experiencing any of the following:
 - Fever, Cough, Headache, Muscle and/or joint pain, Sore throat, Chills, Runny nose, Nasal congestion, Conjunctivitis, Dizziness, Confusion, Fatigue, Nausea/vomiting, Diarrhea, Loss of appetite, Loss of taste or smell, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing https://www.saskatchewan.ca/government/health-care-administration-and-provider-resources/treatment-procedures-and-guidelines/emerging-public-health-issues/2019-novel-coronavirus/covid-19-self-assessment
- 3.) You will be required to complete a self-assessment on arrival and prior to entering the church.
- 4.) Please enter the church through the North door. The main doors will be locked and are for exit only.
- 5.) Sanitize hands when entering using the sanitizer provided.
- 6.) **Sit in designated seating only** families and bubbles may sit together only if a 2 metres of physical distance is maintained from other mass attendees.
- 7.) Follow instructions provided by the community leader regarding how to receive communion.
- 8.) Immediately exit the church form either door after Mass. Lingering afterward or gathering on church property is prohibited at this time.
- 9.) Washrooms are for emergency use ONLY at this time.
- 10.) If you do not have a face mask, the church can provide you with one.
- 11.) Collection is to be placed in baskets prior to entering the sanctuary. Collection baskets WILL NOT be passed around.
