POPE'S INTENTIONS FOR NOVEMBER 2016

Pastor's Message...

Last Sunday we reflected on 'we are Advent's people' in the sense that we are Christians trying to experience the presence of God in our lives and to live in his presence. After our lives on earth, we will continue to live in God's presence and even share in God's own life. This is all about our Christian life.

This Sunday's gospel is commonly called the eschatological discourse. The fall of the Temple is connected with the end of the world. The signs Jesus mentions can be observed in every age. They indicate that the end is indeed coming, but they are no help in determining the day or the hour. However, the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem had happened about the year 70 A.D.

As people of Advent, even though not all of us live until his coming at the end of time, we are all called to be witnesses to Christ during our whole lives on earth. We are not all called to shed our blood but we are all called to live our lives as martyrs. By our own strength we cannot be faithful witnesses to Christ but if we are willing to live as his witnesses the Lord will certainly help us make it possible.

It is not the matter of truth or untrue about what is going to happen but the important thing is that do we determine to follow our Lord or not. The martyrs and all the saints are not different from us. Their only difference is that they were really aware of who Jesus is and totally put their trust in Him. May all of us also determine to follow Jesus and totally put our trust in Him. This must be shown in our lives.


