ASK FATHER JAMES:

"I Believe in the Holy Spirit"

In the Nicene Creed, during our profession of faith, we confess belief in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, and the giver of life... and that the Holy Spirit, together with the Father and Son are to be glorified. However, many Christians while professing their faith in the Father and the Son, hardly show their faith in the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel text, John 20:19-23, Jesus breathed on the Apostles and said: "Receive the Holy Spirit." The Church celebrates Pentecost because it is the day Jesus empowered believers. In Acts 2:1-11, at the Jerusalem at Pentecost, the Holy Spirit was poured out to give life-giving power to the Church. The Holy Spirit is the sustenance that makes all believers and the Church flourish. He is Lord and giver of life. The Holy Spirit gave the distraught apostles who locked themselves behind closed doors, back their lives. It gave the distraught early church who were gathered in Jerusalem after the ascension thinking that Jesus' departure meant it was all over, back their lives. If you want your life back, pray to the Holy Spirit.


