AN EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE



1ST COMMANDMENT: I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD. YOU SHALL HAVE NO OTHER GODS BEFORE ME.

- * Do I truly love God more than anyone or anything else? Or do I just fit Him in when it's convenient?
- * Are there false gods (such as popularity, horoscopes, money, youthfulness, beauty, etc) that I worship by giving them more attention than I give the true God? Are material possessions running my life?
- * Do I spend some quality time in prayer each day?

2ND COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD YOUR GOD IN VAIN.

- * Have I used any curse words?
- * Did I use the Name of Jesus Christ as an expression of anger or surprise?
- * Am I indifferent (don't care) when actor/actresses use blasphemy on TV or at the movies or when musicians use it in their music?
- * Do I listen to music which disrespects God and what is holy and sacred?

3RD COMMANDMENT: REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE LORD'S DAY.

- * Have I been faithful in celebrating Sunday Mass?
- * Have I taken time to celebrate confession on a regular basis or do I believe I don't need to make use of the Lord's Sacrament?
- * Have I allowed myself to get too busy with my work and chores that I don't reserve any time for spiritual and family activities?
- * Do I give my body the rest it needs?
- * Have I deliberately come late or left early from Mass without good reason?

4TH COMMANDMENT: HONOUR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER.

- * Have I shown love and respect for my parents, even if they have grown old and forgetful?
- * Have I deliberately hurt my parents?
- * Do I help my parents with chores and by obeying their orders?
- * Do I pray for my parents?
- * Do I take time to visit with my parents/grandparents if they are old and sick or housebound?

5TH COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT MURDER.

- * Have I had serious thoughts of anger and hatred towards others?
- * Am I withholding forgiveness from anyone?
- * Have I gotten drunk or used drugs?
- * Do I encourage others to get drunk or use drugs?
- * Do I neglect my soul by spending time with those who lead me into sin?
- * Do I think of the poor and try to assist them?
- * Do I enjoy music which encourages hatred?
- * Have I harmed others by teasing them or bullying them?
- * Have I laughed at other people and harmfully embarrassed them?
- * Have I had an abortion or encouraged an abortion or participated in an abortion?

6TH COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.

Have I respected the gift of sexuality and the human body?

Have I had sexual relations outside of marriage? Have I accepted that sex is for married people so they can have children and show a life-long committed love for one another?

Have I encouraged the wrong use of sexuality by looking at movies, pornography or images that lead me to lust?

Have I tried to be pure in my thoughts, words, and actions by myself and with others?

Do I deliberately spend time in impure daydreaming?

7TH COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.

Have I shoplifted – no matter how little an item was?

Have I destroyed the property of others?

Have I stolen the property of others – even if little things?

Am I envious about what others have without being grateful for my own blessings?

Am I greedy and selfish?

Do I try to share what I have with the poor?

8TH COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOUR.

Do I have the habit of lying?

Do I lie in order to avoid punishment or to make myself look good in the eyes of others?

Do I gossip and spread rumors about others – even if I think they are true?

Do I allow prejudice and hatred towards other nationalities, races, and religions?

Have I cheated or plagiarized on an exam or paper?

9TH COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOUR'S WIFE.

Have I contemplated infidelity in my marriage?

Have I upheld the dignity of my spouse in all situations?

Am I irresponsible about what I read or watch – filling my mind with unhealthy images or stories?

10TH COMMANDMENT: YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOUR'S GOODS.

Do I compare myself with others in terms of wealth or popularity?

Am I jealous of others people's qualities and possessions?

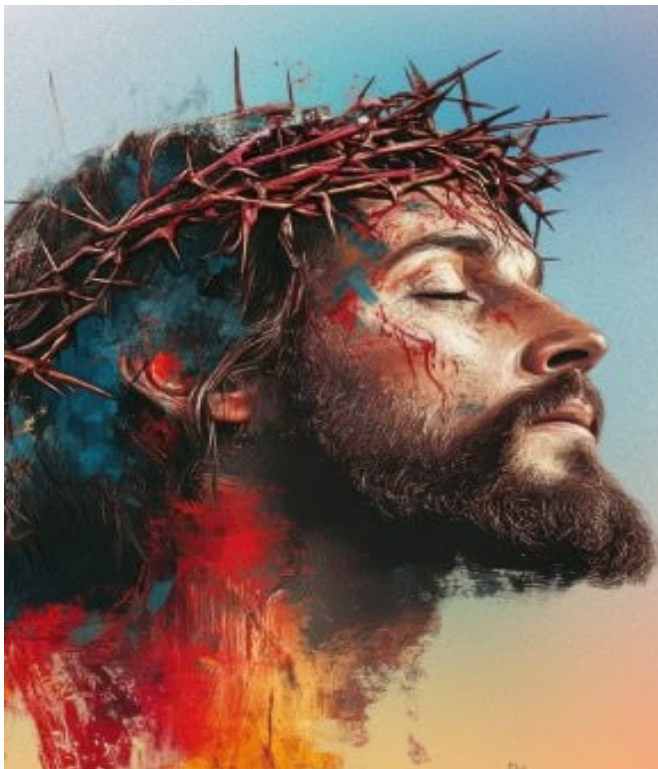
Do I spend and save money wisely?

Do I practice good stewardship – by sharing wisely with others my time, talent and treasure?

Even as the Lord reveals our sin to us, the Holy Spirit – Who is the Love of God poured into our hearts – wants to encourage us and strengthen us with the knowledge that we are dearly loved sons and daughters of God. The Lord does not show us sin simply to make us feel guilty, but to free us from it's power and to release His life more fully in us.
