ASK FATHER JAMES:

Giving up everything to possess that Treasure and Pearl of Great Value

Since the beginning of time, people worldwide have been searching for meaning. This search has led people to searching and digging, for treasures. In today's gospel text, (Matthew 13:44-52), Jesus tells parables about searching for treasures and pearls. Pearl is one of the world's oldest, most desired, and most spectacular gems. In the parable, Jesus talks about the willingness to go and sell everything and return to buy the pearl of great treasure. St. Irenaeus held that the treasure was Christ, and the field was the Scriptures. We all are on this great expedition to finding God. What is everything that we are ready and willing to give up for it? Jesus on his part gave up everything (his life on the cross) and redeemed (bought) salvation, the New Covenant by his blood. The repetition of the phrase, "sold all that he had" in the text, indicates the seriousness with which the disciple should take the kingdom of God. Again, St. Irenaeus says: "When a man will venture nothing for Christ's sake, we must draw the sorrowful conclusion that he has not got the grace of God."
