except of course for funeral and other specific religious event !*

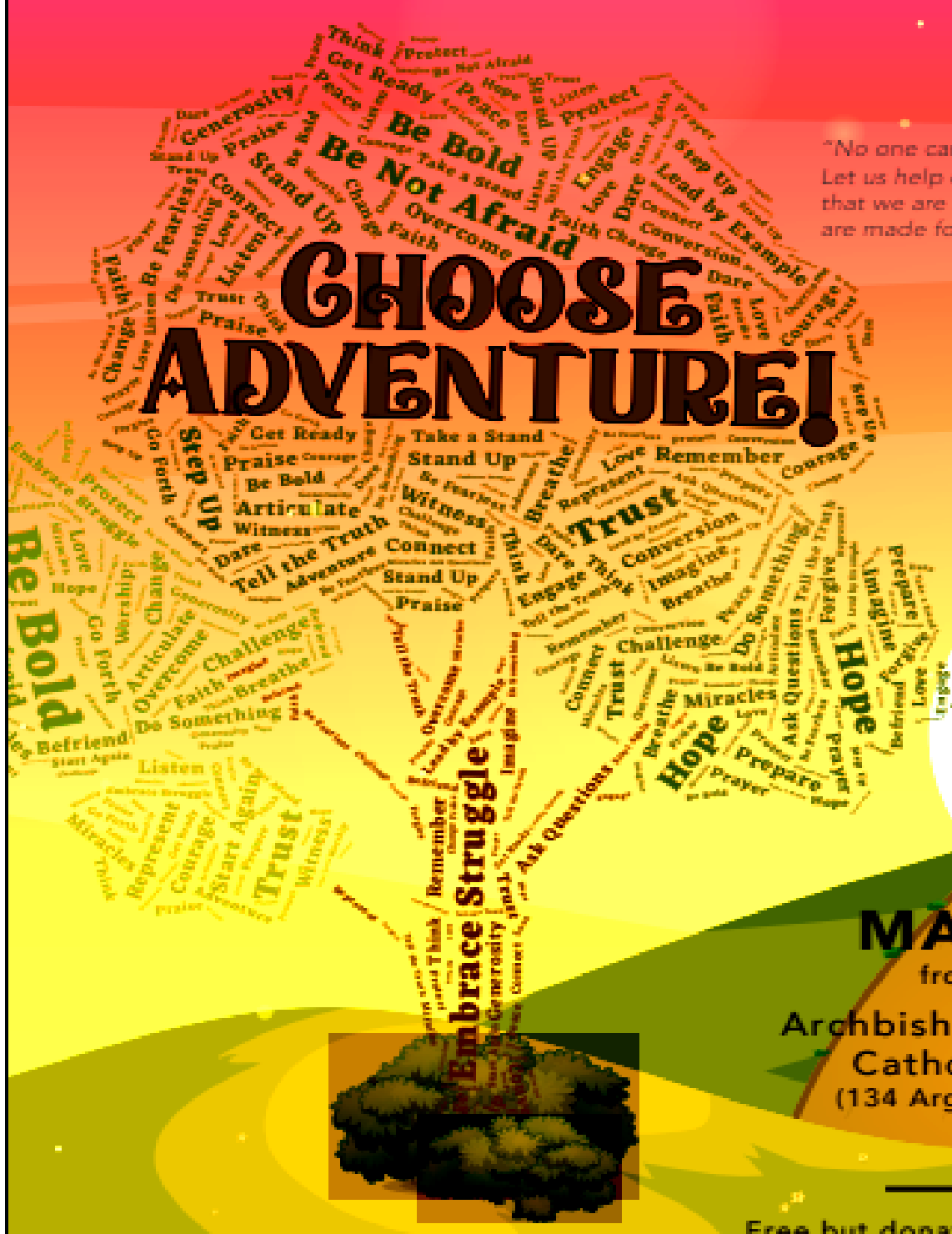
