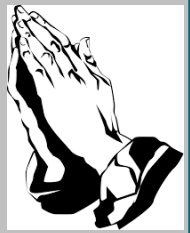
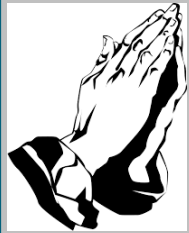

ASK FATHER JAMES:

“He descended into Hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into Heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father.”

The Apostles' Creed summarizes the theological significance of the ascension as the climax of redemption using the above creedal formula, which helps us understand that when He descended into the dead – by his Ascension Christ leads the souls of the Old Testament patriarchs out of hell and into heaven. His ascension is the fulfilment of what Christ himself said: 'I go to prepare a place for you, and I will come again and receive you to myself so that where I am there you may be also.' (John 14:3). We too hope to make heaven someday. This Weekend's liturgy celebrates this joyful realization that heaven is the goal.

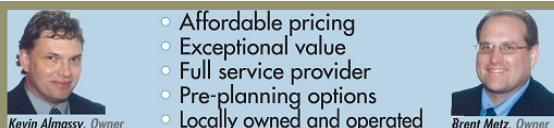
