6th Sunday of Ordinary Time

"Soft people in the church, those who are double minded and wish to run from the truth, will tell pastors not to preach about abortion. 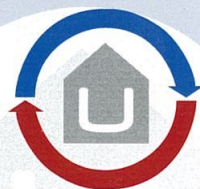
