ASK FATHER JAMES:

The bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world (John 6:51)

Today's celebration (Body and Blood of Christ) provides an opportunity to focus more particularly on the mystery that we celebrate every time we come together in thanksgiving to God at the Holy Eucharist. From the very beginning of God's Holy Book, the Book of Genesis, we see the presence of God in the bread and wine. Melchizedek, King of Salem brought out bread and wine" (Genesis 14: 17-20). Later, in the Book of Exodus, God gave the people the gift of bread in the story of the manna in the wilderness (Ex. 16: 1-36). Ever since then, the daily life of the people has been the remembrance of the life-saving Given bread and this have been central in the covenant faith of Israel in the Temple.

In today's text, Jesus tells the people, "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink... and that "the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world." Jesus invites them and us to his real body which he left us as a memorial at the Last Supper. Just like the manna then, in the Body of Christ, God gives us Jesus as food for the journey in the wilderness. Jesus explains that the food he will give them is not like the manna of the Exodus period. They ate the manna for forty years until they came to the border of the Promised Land (Exodus 16: 12-35) but that his body as food "endures to eternal life."
