ASK FATHER JAMES:

Eucharistic Gathering is the Hospitality of Jesus

Matthew 10:37-43 is one of the very challenging messages of Jesus. In v. 37, Jesus says: "Anyone who loves their father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves their son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me..." Jesus challenges us to revise our priorities of hanging out with our father, mother, son, or daughter. Jesus challenges us to welcome him. In v.40, Jesus gives the summary of who a Christian or a body of Christians (Church) should be: He uses the word dechomai = "welcome" or "receive." A Christian is one who welcomes the Word of God who became flesh (Bible and Eucharist) and welcomes people gathered to celebrate this as liturgy. This Word continually becomes flesh at every Eucharistic celebration and gives himself to us as Host. To "welcome" a person means to show hospitality. Hospitality is the process by means by which a stranger is taken under the protection of a host (patron) for a given time.

God's presence is always and forever available to us in and through Jesus. The only requirement is that we open our hearts. The more extravagant the welcome, the greater the refreshment, the deeper the grounding, the clearer the enlightenment, and the stronger the inspiration that will flow from it. In v.41, he says... The one who welcomes [dechomai] a prophet in the name of a prophet the reward of a prophet. A prophet is one sent by God to proclaim God's presence. Jesus is prophet, priest, and king who comes to proclaim the kingdom of God to us. All the baptized should take seriously the understanding that they are welcoming Christ's presence in the world. All church congregations should take seriously the understanding that they are gathered at every Eucharistic celebration to continue to welcome Christ and the one who sent him.


Refugee Field Worker
