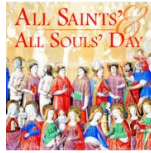

REFLECTION

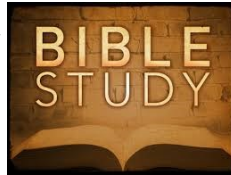
