ASK FATHER JAMES:

Foundations of our Understanding of the Trinity

Trinity Sunday is a feast held on the Sunday after Pentecost Sunday praying for the ever-continuous blessing of the Trinity, the threefold nature of God. Although the actual word Trinity is not in the Bible, the Greek word Trias or the Latin Trinitas or "Trinity" is explained in the Catechism of the Catholic Church thus: "The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons. ... The divine Persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God, whole and entire." (CCC. #253). At the Ascension, Jesus gave the baptismal formula, when he directed his disciples to baptize in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. By this initiation rite, Christ inaugurates and endorses the doctrine of the Trinity in his Church. This Trinitarian formula reflects the equality of the Trinitarian persons. Christ presents all three persons having one name, as a unified and equal, singular whole, and uses this singular name of the three for holy baptism.




