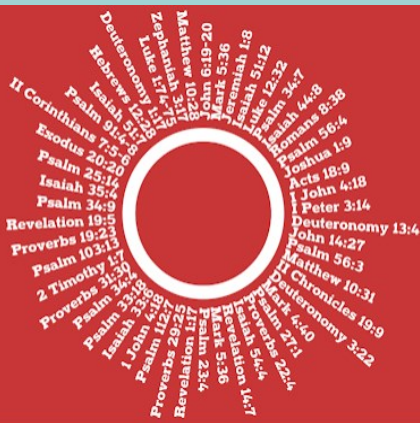

ASK FATHER JAMES:

**Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul
(Matthew 10:28)**

'Do not be afraid...', is the exhortation of Jesus to his apostles and to us today. We live in a society that is seemingly enmeshed in endless attack on Christ, the church, and our faith and family values. We can sometimes feel defeated. It would seem like that have killed us by their political correctness agenda. Jesus says, "they cannot kill your soul" (the spirit of Christ given by God through the Holy Spirit).

Like those early believers, we too, the disciples will face lethal opposition, but we should not fear "those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul." Opposition, discrimination, rejection, and violent repression have always been the lot from the very beginning of those who carry the name of Jesus and proclaim His good news of salvation. Like them, let us continue to nourish our souls with the Body and Blood of Christ. This is why we dare to come to Mass, despite every opposition to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist.

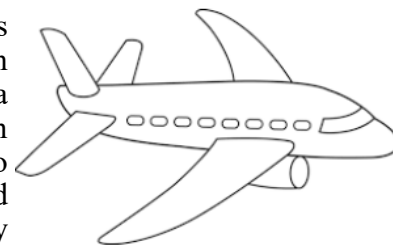
