REFLECTION

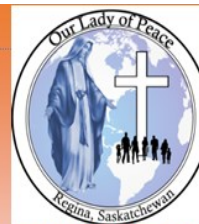
There is something special going on in the readings today. The parable of the wedding banquet is a striking commentary by Jesus towards the Jewish people. The invited guests initially represent those Israelites who lost focus on their relationship with God, either by being bewitched by riches or ignoring the prophets. The people who are invited to the banquet in their place represent the Gentiles, meaning that Christ has come not only to the Jewish people but to the entire world. The guest caught without a wedding garment is understood to be someone who is not committed to a relationship with Christ. It is critically important to engage and dialogue with those of other religions and creeds to work towards building the kingdom of God, enabling all to have a relationship with Christ. Your contributions to the Archbishop's Appeal support the work of interreligious and ecumenical dialogue, allowing the opportunity for all to come to the wedding feast of the Lamb.
