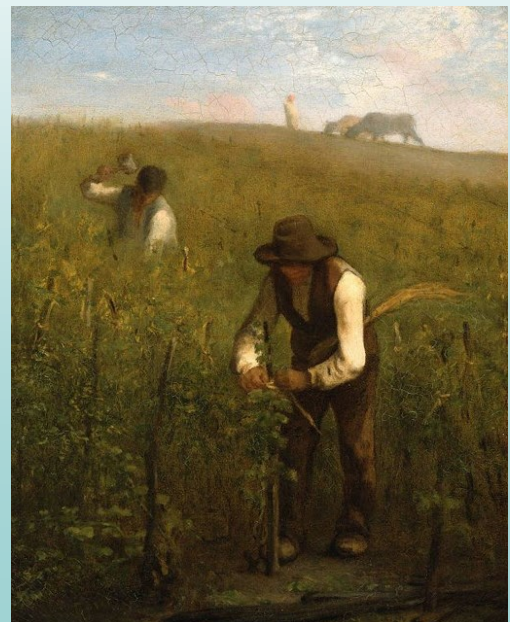

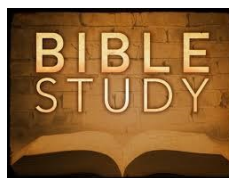
Cultural experience and teaching through traditional Pow Wow dancing and singing with Indigenous children and youth; steps towards healing and reconciliation.


