Visitation House Supported Through Queen City Marathon 2023

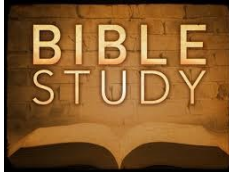


